





Step 1: Ask the question, have you ever heard of the 3 circles? Can I share it with you?

Step 2: Watch the 3 circles video OR show the picture with them and read the script below

- The first circle represents our broken world: We all live in a broken world. What are some things you see in the world that are broken?
- The 2nd circle is God's original design. A world full of love, joy and peace and unity with one another and in relationship with Him.
- Starting with the first person, we decide we don't want to do things God's ways, this is called sin. Sin can be anything from lying to murder. Sin separates us from God and throws us into brokenness.
- Since we were created to be in relationship with God, when we are in brokenness, there is a void in our life. We try to fill the void with things like fame, money, and relationships. Or, we try to drown out those bad feelings and struggles with things like drugs, alcohol, food, television, pornography, video games, etc. to try and make us feel good. These things won't fix the problem and can lead to addiction. If we die in this state of brokenness, that is eternal separation from God, which is eternity in hell.
- BUT, God loved us so much that He didn't want to leave us in this place, so He sent His son Jesus to die on the cross for us to pay the penalty for our sins and make a way for us to have a relationship with God again.
- If we turn from our way of doing things, ask for forgiveness, and make Jesus the Lord of our life then He fills us with His Holy Spirit. We are then restored back into a relationship with God again and He starts to renew us from the inside out.
 We get to experience His love, joy, and peace in our lives.

Step 3: Ask the following question & respond appropriately based on their answer: What circle would you see yourself in?

If in brokenness, ask these questions:

- What's stopping you from leaving brokenness and following Jesus? Are you open to making a decision to follow Jesus today?
 - If yes, they are a GREEN- Great! Can we pray together? This prayer isn't what changes you, this is you just making a decision to follow Jesus

- PRAYER: "God, I know that I have broken your laws and have done things to offend you. My sins have separated me from you. I am truly sorry, please forgive me, and transform me from the inside out. I believe that Jesus died for my sins, and that you raised Him from the dead. Jesus, thank you for dying for me and paying the penalty for my sins. I want to follow you from this day forward and make you the Lord of my life forever. Please fill me with your Holy Spirit to help me obey You and experience all God has for me. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
- Ask if you can set up a time to start meeting and reading scripture to learn what it means to follow Jesus. Ask if they have any other friends who might want to join you. Be sure to get their contact info if you don't already have it. Also, be sure to invite them to church and/or youth group with you.
- If no, move to next question
- Are you at least open to learning more about Jesus before making a decision to follow Him?
 - If yes, they are a YELLOW- Ask if you can set up a time to start meeting and
 reading scripture, ask questions, and learn more about who Jesus is. Ask if they
 have any other friends who might want to join you. Be sure to get their contact
 info if you don't already have it. Also, be sure to invite them to church and/or
 youth group with you.
 - If no, they are a RED- thank them for listening and let them know if they ever have questions or change their mind, you are here for them.

If they are already believers (BLUE) ask these questions:

- I would love to hear your story, how did you come to know and follow Jesus?
- Do you think it's important to share your faith? Why or why not?
- On a scale of 1-10 how confident do you feel being able to share your faith?
- Would you be interested in some training and tools to help you feel more confident in sharing your faith? Do you have any friends that would want to join you?
 - If they say yes, get their contact info, if you don't already have it, and ask them if you can share it with the Collision staff at your school so they can reach out and set up a time to meet with them about starting or joining a team!

Step 4: Start a Disciple Making Group (DMG) with GREENS and YELLOWS - and invite them to church and/or youth group

Step 5: Meet with your Disciple Making Group (DMG)

You can meet with your DMG as often as you like, but we suggest meeting NO LESS than once a week. If there is time, we suggest you do the first lesson with them right away when they say yes to meeting with you.
